## **Shoe Away Hunger**

Thank you all for donating the 120 pairs of shoes that were recently delivered to Minneapolis. Those shoes were sorted and then put on a bus to go to poorer areas of Minneapolis. They were sold for a nominal price and that money goes to provide food for the hungry.

With their various contacts, Shoe Away Hunger is able to feed 1 person for 7 days for \$2.50. In May, they fed 19,000 individuals with 7 days of groceries. In June, they fed 14,000 people. Currently they have over 21 hunger relief sites.

So as you can see, this is an easy way for us to help others. We can just check our closets for wearable shoes we no longer use and bring them to the church. Tie the shoelaces together or rubber band them together and put them in the box by the church office. They are certainly appreciated and we thank you for your support!
