Upcoming Worship Opportunities

<u>We will have two sermon series for Advent and Christmas.</u> As we close the *God's Greater Story* sermon series on Romans we also come the the beginning of a new Church Year. The Sundays in Advent will follow a series on the "Jesse Tree." An ancient tradition in the Christian Church used as a countdown to Christmas Day. We will have some material you can use at home with your family that will coincide with this series.

The Wednesday services will call us to *Behold the Child* as we explore who Jesus is, why He came, and what He came to offer. Namely "peace on earth and good will among those with whom he is pleased." (Luke 2:14)

December 23 an Advent service will be held at 6:30 for those who wish to attend. **Christmas Eve** has always been a service with a full attendance. This year to accommodate the potentially larger crowd we will schedule 4 services on Christmas Eve. We will ask you to sign up for a service, to ensure we do not get too many in the sanctuary. Services are limited to 30 people. They will be as follows:

3:30pm "Sermon: Jesus: The First Fruits of Jesse's Tree" This will be a candlelight service. It will be dark enough in the sanctuary for the candles but light enough for those who would like to avoid driving home in the dark. (Sunset of Christmas Eve this year is at 4:30pm.)

6:30pm "Sermon: Behold the Child Jesus: Son of Mary" This service will finalize the "*Behold the Child*" series. This service will also close with candlelight.

9:00pm "Sermon: Jesus: The First Fruits of Jesse's Tree" This will be a candlelight service and a duplicate of the 3:30pm service.

11:00pm "Sermon: Why Did Jesus Come" This will be a modified Compline service, for those of you familiar with the Hours of the Church. This will be a candlelight service concluding at about midnight welcoming the New Born King.

On Christmas Day we will have a service at 10:00am with a message titled, "*Infinite Gifts in Finite Wrappings*." This will be a service similar to those of past years celebrating the wonder found in Jesus the Holy Christ of God.
