**Could You Save a Life?** What if you or a loved one had a heart attack in church? An AED (automated external defibrillator) could save your life. Did you know we have 2 of them right in the church? One is by the east entry door and one is in Schleicher Hall by the kitchen door. They are semi-automatic and pretty easy for a lay person to administer. But who knows how to do that, you may ask? We think very few. And the question is, will one of those few who know how be in church the Sunday you may need an AED? We need more volunteers like you to learn so you could save a life. It only takes 38 minutes to watch a video on the internet to learn how. Our AED units will actually talk to you and guide you through an emergency, but there still is a bit more to know and that is what the video is about. During any Sunday service we would like to have a few people who know how, and I hope you are one of them. Seriously, please consider watching the video so you know how.
