UPDATE

By vote of the Voters' Assembly on Sunday, October 2, 2022, the call process proceeds at St. John's as normal, calling the next regular, tenured pastor and not an intentional interim pastor to serve on a temporary basis.

The next step in the call process is to develop a Call List.

The Call Committee has already completed work on the pre-call documents: Congregational Self-Study, Congregational Checklist, and Congregational Profile. After posting them at church for comment and correction or amendment, they were forwarded to the District the first full week of October. These documents collect information about the parish and her needs and desires for her next pastor. The District President utilizes them in conjunction with complementary informational documents from Synod pastors to match pastoral candidates with St. John's.

The congregation's part in developing a Call List is the nomination of candidates for pastor. A mailing went out the first full week of October inviting member participation in what is required by St. John's bylaws: "Every congregational member shall have the privilege of nominating candidates" (1.2). The same bylaw requires the Call Committee to "submit all of the names nominated to the District President, together with a request for his recommendations, information, and evaluation." Please return all nomination forms included with the mailing by mail or in person to the church office by Tuesday, October 18, 2022. Additional forms may be obtained from the church office.

It is hoped that the Call Committee shall have a Call List from which to work before the end of the month. The full Call List will be shared with the congregation when it is received along with information about further steps in the call process: screening the candidates for preparation of a preferred list and electing a pastor by ballot at a Call Meeting of the voters.

Pastoral support through the vacancy is being addressed by the Board of Elders.

The elders will continue to schedule pastors for the Sunday 9:00 AM Divine Service and 10:15 AM Bible Study. Pastor Olana will have care of the shut-ins and Confirmation instruction. And Pastor Krusemark will serve as the emergency contact, 507-450-2012 until further notice. Pastor Krusemark will also attend regular and special meetings of the elders, the Call Committee, the Council, and the Voters' Assembly.

It is hoped that a regular vacancy pastor can be secured to cover many or most of the above pastoral services and others himself. We would also request of him to support continued work on the reconciliation process as developed by the elders in consultation with Pastor Krusemark.
