Call Update

The Call Committee (President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Elders) has received a Call List of twelve pastors from the District office with accompanying information on each candidate. The committee met to begin to process this material on November 8, 2022 ahead of the Council meeting on the same evening. The members of the committee met again on November 16, 2022 and agreed to inquire of five candidates. After brief exchanges by phone with these five, three were willing to be considered for the call and so will constitute the preferred list. The committee intends to gather further information from the three pastors. Congregation members shall please submit questions or subjects to the Call Committee they would like explored with the candidates.

To preserve the integrity of this process, specific information on the candidates, including their names, will not be shared in communications that are accessible by the general public as, for example, on the church's website. Please then begin to watch the bulletin boards at church for communication from the Call Committee. In due course, the full Call List received from the District will be shared along with a list of preferred candidates screened by the Call Committee. Biographical and other information about the candidates on the preferred list will also be posted. Copies of all posted materials may also be prepared for circulation among the membership.

When a slate of preferred candidates and their biographical sketches are prepared, the Church Council will call a Call Meeting of the voters for election, publicizing it in the church bulletin at least two Sundays in advance.
